EIC main calls in 2023 - Overview



Plug-in Scheme

- A novelty under Horizon Europe and a specific scheme applicable only to the EIC Accelerator.
- Applies to applications that result from existing national or regional programmes.
- No direct application to the EIC Accelerator call. Instead, a **project review** at national or regional level assessing the innovation or market deployment potential of an existing project.
- Projects submitted to the EIC Accelerator, fulfill the following conditions:
 - the proposal meets the two first award criteria of the EIC Accelerator (excellence and impact);
 - there is no duplication of funding of activities and costs to be supported under the EIC Accelerator with the existing grant allocated at national or regional level;
 - the applicant meets the eligibility criteria for the EIC Accelerator.

Next generation innovation talents scheme

To allow eligible **researchers** (from Pathfinder, ERC, MSCA, RI, EIT) to carry out an innovation **internship in a hosting company** (EIC, EIT) for 3-6 months:

- **Deep tech research talents** (3-6 months) dedicated to highly specialised work on specific project, requested by the hosting company. This component is expected to attract the interest mostly of **ERC, EIC Pathfinder, MSCA fellows** along with EIT supported postdocs/doctoral candidates and EIT Alumni and EIT Jumpstarter beneficiaries;
- **Aspiring innovators** (up to 6 months) dedicated to more generic work in the host organisation. This component is expected to attract the interest mostly of **EIT students and graduates.**

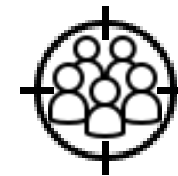

Actions for further consideration

Stimulating Experimentation Practices

- Identification of an area where innovative technologies emerge, justifying why experimentation in this area is essential
-  • Development of an action plan aiming to set up an experimentation space (regulatory sandbox, living lab, test bed) to examine the potential of a particular innovative solution
- Set up the experimentation space proposed in the action plan

Implementing co-funded action plans for connected regional innovation valleys

-  • Create **connected regional innovation valleys**, involving regions with lower innovation performances, by building on strategic areas of regional strength and specialisation, in support of key EU priorities

Actions for further consideration

Expanding Academia-Enterprise Collaborations



- Creation of innovation ecosystems with educational & research institutions
- Support educational & research institutions to take a greater entrepreneurial role
- Leverage best practices of the P&P sector in the EU's well performing innovation hubs & enhance collaborations between businesses with R&I actors in educational & research institutions
